A MESSAGE FROM FR. BARRETT

The Lord be with you!

He said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" And he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep." (Jn. 21:17)

Thank you all for your continued support of our holiday food basket ministry. This is one of the oldest, if not the oldest of our outreach ministries. It has been led faithfully since 2003 by Al Sickle when the priest at that time asked Al to replace a volunteer who was stepping down. Over the years this ministry has evolved. It has been going on so long that Al can't remember how many families were on the original list. Also, many of the faithful members who served in this ministry have gone on to their reward. It started with members asked to bring food donations which were stored in a member's garage. A car pool of members brought the food to the church where it was stored in the large classroom where EOF now meets. It was then assembled and boxed for delivery.

The first evolution was to prepare a master list of needed items and shop local stores for the best prices. The food was then assembled in the kitchen. Imagine lots of people bumping into each other in a small area! The decision was soon made to move into the sanctuary and form an assembly line. That system is still in use today. Also, there was a concern that member's vehicles could be damaged by hauling heavy loads of food. Passenger cars, even the much heavier ones then, were never designed to haul freight. The members chipped in and rented a truck. A truck is still used as part of this ministry.

All the food purchased by Advent is delivered by truck to the church where an assembly line of volunteers working in the sanctuary divides it into identical boxes for delivery to the schools. Once the food is assembled into boxes it is delivered to the schools which requested holiday boxes.

We provide this ministry to the community three times a year-Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter. Our last offering was 137 boxes to six schools at a cost of around \$6200. The baskets feed over 800 individuals each holiday. We are a modest sized congregation, even at our pre-Covid peak, but we have done this faithfully three times a year for over 25 years. We have never had to support this ministry with money from the General Fund. This is a tremendous example that we are not just hearers of the Word but doers of the Word as the apostles James admonish us.

We have formed a committee and are exploring ideas to continue funding this ministry for many more years. You should have received an e-mail by now in conjunction with our latest idea which is partnering on the internet with "Go Fund Me." We will be exploring other ideas, but I believe the backbone of this ministry will and should always be our faithful members. Thanks to all for your gifts of time, talent, and money.
